When it comes to paranormal equipment there are many different rumors and theories floating about. Some people even talk about the fabled 'Ghost Detector', however logical thinking would fault such an idea.

To detect a 'Ghost', first we must know what a ghost consists of physically and secondly how to detect such traits.
